**Subject: Conflict Minerals Statement**

Dear Valued Customer,

In July of 2010, the United States Congress passed legislation requiring that publicly traded companies in the US and governed by the Securities & Exchange Commission (SEC), report the use of “Conflict Minerals” in the manufacture of their products. “Conflict Minerals” refer to specific minerals (Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten and Gold) sourced from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries.

Products manufactured at Tempco Electric Heater Corp contain no such conflict minerals and we continually work with our suppliers to maintain this compliance.

Although Tempco Electric Heater Corporation is not a publicly traded company, and therefore not directly subject to this law, we are providing this declaration to our downstream customers to help them comply with any obligations relative to this law.
