

Installation & Operating Manual: TEC95030

3-Heat Wood Pellet BBQ Grill Controller





INTRODUCTION:

Thank you for purchasing Tempco's TEC95030 3-Heat Wood Pellet BBQ Grill Controller. The TEC95030 can be used as a replacement for the original control.

The TEC95030 is compatible with the following wood pellet grill companies:

- Traeger Company
- Royall
- BLAZ'N
- IPT Sink


WARNING: Verify that the controller's Power Switch is **OFF** and the line cord plug is disconnected from the outlet, before removing your old controller and installing the new Wood Pellet BBQ Grill Controller. **Failure to heed this warning could result in bodily harm.**

Removing the Existing Wood Pellet Controller

- 1. Make sure the grill is unplugged from the outlet before proceeding.
- 2. Gain access to the controller wiring harness below the pellet hopper. Sometimes, there is a protective panel below the hopper. Remove and set aside.
- 3. Disconnect all four 2-pin plastic electrical connectors by pulling them apart.
- 4. Remove the controller from the grill by unscrewing the two faceplate screws. Save the screws for mounting your new TEC95030 Controller.
- 5. Gently pull the control out of the panel cutout, being careful of the Printed Circuit Board and wiring harness.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Feed the wire harness back through the panel cutout, being careful with the Printed Circuit board.
- 2. Using the previously saved mounting screws, secure the controller.
- 3. Working under the pellet hopper, plug in all four 2-pin wiring connectors as follows, refer to the wire diagram.



4. Re-install the access panel under the Pellet Hopper if it was removed.

OPERATION:

- 1. Verify the Selector Switch is in the **OFF** position and plug the grill into a properly grounded electrical output.
- 2. Turn the Selector Switch to **Smoke** or any of the nine temperature settings.
- 3. The ventilation/draft fan and the auger pellet feed motor turns on.
- 4. The ignitor/cartridge heater will turn on to ignite the wood pellets in the fire pot. After four minutes, the ignitor/cartridge heater will turn off.
- 5. Set the Selector Switch to your cook temperature and enjoy.
